

DOWNTOWN PARKING

STATION SQUARE PARKING

If you choose to park at Station Square, Gateway Clipper shuttle boats board two hours before the game and run every 5-30 minutes until the game starts. Return trips to Station Square begin in the third quarter and continue until after the game is over. Roundtrip tickets cost \$8.00 each. NORTH SHORE PARKING

If you are coming from the North, you should park on the North Shore. Parking options include Allegheny Center garage, North Shore garage, and the River Road surface lots.

WHERE DO I PARK?

IF YOU'RE COMING FROM THE EAST, WEST OR SOUTH...

If you're coming from the EAST, WEST or SOUTH – parking downtown will be the best place for you. You can then get to Heinz Field by walking over the Ft. Duquesne Bridge, or walking over the Clemente Bridge. With many downtown parking options costing only \$5.00 on game days, it's an easy and cost effective way to get to Heinz Field. After the game, if you're traveling SOUTH or WEST, you'll have easy access to the Ft. Pitt Bridge/Tunnel and the Liberty Bridge/Tunnel via the Sixth Avenue entrance ramp. If you're headed EAST, you'll have easy access to I-376 (Parkway East) via Seventh Avenue or the Boulevard of the Allies. Another option is to park at Station Square and take the Gateway Clipper shuttle to and from Heinz Field.

IF YOU'RE COMING FROM THE NORTH...

If you're coming from the NORTH, you should park in the NORTH! Your best parking choice is to use one of the North Shore garages around Federal Street. By staying on the North Shore, you'll have the easiest access after the game to North I-279 via the HOV or Route 28.

EXITING AFTER EVENTS

TO EAST I-376, FROM:

NORTH SHORE, VIA

- WEST END BRIDGE: New, 3-Lanes Southbound – USE LEFT LANE
- FT. DUQUESNE BRIDGE: New, Allegheny Ave. 2-Lanes Northbound – USE RIGHT LANE

DOWNTOWN, VIA

- 7th Ave. to Blvd. of the Allies Entrance
- Blvd. of the Allies to I-376 Ramp

TO SOUTH/WEST I-279, RTE. 51, RTE. 19, FROM:

NORTH SHORE, VIA

- WEST END BRIDGE: New, 3-Lanes Southbound – USE RIGHT LANES
- FT. DUQUESNE BRIDGE: Reedsdale Underpass

DOWNTOWN, VIA

- LIBERTY BRIDGE & TUNNEL
- FT. PITT BRIDGE & TUNNEL

TO NORTH FROM NORTH SHORE:

I-279, VIA

- HOV from Mazerowski Way
- HOV from Lacock & Anderson
- North Avenue at Madison

RTE. 28, VIA

- East Ohio Street
- General Robinson Street

RTE. 65, VIA

- HOV to North I-279; South on Camp Home Road to Rte. 65 (at Emsworth)
- From Western Avenue

ALTERNATE EXIT ROUTES TO SOUTH I-279

TO BEAVER AND BUTLER COUNTIES:

I-279 NORTH

- HOV to North I-279; then North on I-79

RTE. 65 NORTH

- North on Rte. 65 (via HOV to North I-279; South on Camp Home Road to Rte. 65) (at Emsworth)

RTE. 51 NORTH

- North on Rte. 51 (via Rte. 65 North; then South on McKees Rocks Bridge to Rte. 51); then North on Neville Road to return to Rte. 51

RTE. 60 NORTH

- South/West on Steuben Street (to Ingram); North on Rte. 60.

TO WASHINGTON AND SOUTHWEST ALLEGHENY COUNTIES:

RTE. 51 NORTH TO I-79 SOUTH

- North on Rte. 51 (via Rte. 65 North; then South on McKees Rocks Bridge to Rte. 51); North on Neville Road; then South on I-79

RTE. 60 NORTH TO I-79 SOUTH

- South/West on Steuben Street (to Ingram); North on Rte. 60; then South on I-79 or West on Rtes. 22/30

RTE. 60 NORTH; RTE. 50 SOUTH TO I-79 SOUTH

- North on Rte. 60 (via Noblestown Road); then South on Rte. 50 to South I-279 (Carnegie) or South I-79 (Kirwan Heights)

RTE. 19 SOUTH

- Truck Rte. 19 (West Liberty Avenue)
- South on Rte. 19 (Banksville Road)

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO AND FROM HEINZ FIELD

FROM THE NORTH:

Please use North Shore Parking for the easiest access and exiting.

VIA I-279 SOUTH BOUND

(suggested route for fans from Beaver and Butler Counties)

- Exit 8B to the Allegheny Center or North Shore garages.
AFTER THE GAME, go to I-279 via the HOV at Lacock and Anderson Streets.

VIA ROUTE 28 SOUTH BOUND

- East Ohio Street Exit to Allegheny Center garage.
AFTER THE GAME, go to Route 28 via East Ohio Street.
- Lacock Street Exit to North Shore garage.
AFTER THE GAME, go to Route 28 via Lacock Street.

VIA ROUTE 65 SOUTH BOUND

- North Shore Ramp to Green Lot 30.
AFTER THE GAME, go to Route 65 via local streets (*Sproat and Fontella*).

FROM THE SOUTH AND WEST:

Please use Downtown Parking for the easiest access and exiting.

VIA I-279 AND ROUTE 19 NORTH BOUND (through the Ft. Pitt Tunnels/Bridge)

- Exit 6B to the Liberty Avenue ramp. Turn right onto the Boulevard of the Allies. Park in the B&B (*old Westinghouse*) garage, the Wood Street and Boulevard of the Allies garage, the Third Avenue garage or the PPG Garage.
AFTER THE GAME, take the Ft. Pitt Bridge/Tunnel or the Boulevard of the Allies entrance to the Liberty Bridge/Tunnels, then to I-279 and Route 19.

VIA ROUTE 51 NORTH BOUND (through the Liberty Tunnels/Bridge to Sixth Avenue)

- Forbes Avenue and Ross Street to the First Side garage. The First Side garage connects to/from the First Avenue "T" Station. You can ride for free to the Gateway Station and walk across the Ft. Duquesne Bridge to Heinz Field.
AFTER THE GAME, take the Boulevard of the Allies entrance to the Liberty Bridge/Tunnels to Route 51.
- Fifth Avenue and Wood Street to the Oliver (*Lazarus*) garage.
AFTER THE GAME, take the Sixth Avenue entrance to the Liberty Bridge/Tunnels to Route 51.
- Sixth Avenue to the Mellon Square garage.
AFTER THE GAME, take the Sixth Avenue entrance to the Liberty Bridge/Tunnels to Route 51.

FROM THE EAST:

Please use Downtown Parking for the easiest access and exiting.

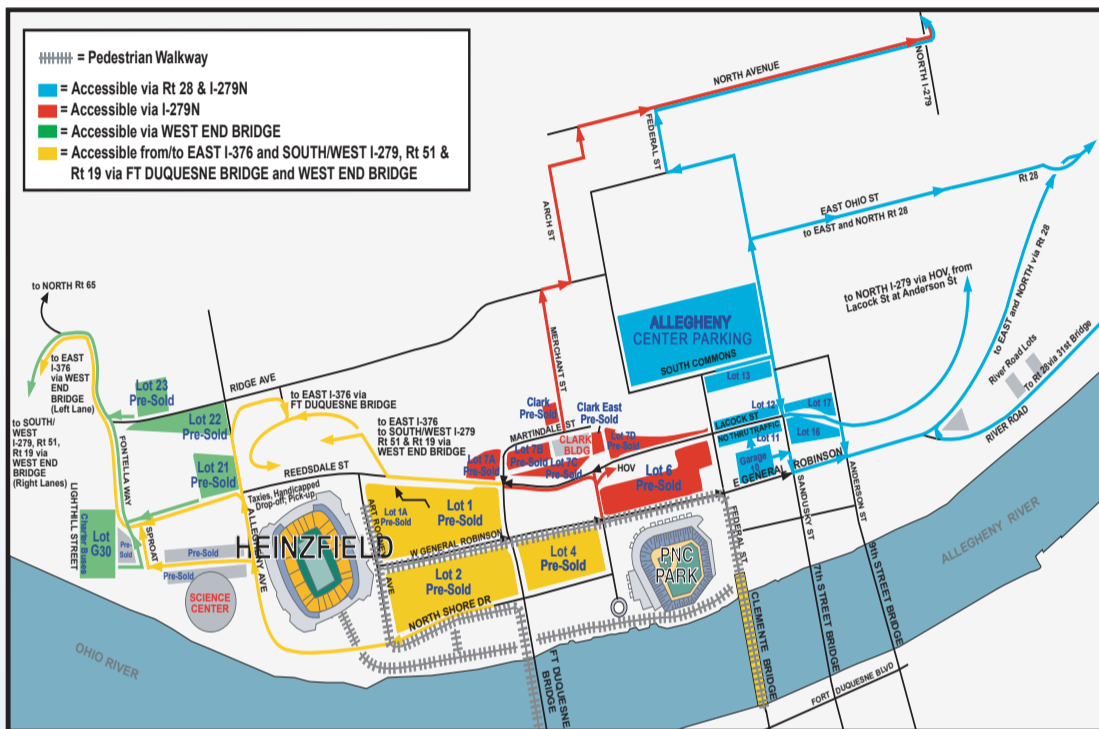
VIA I-376 WEST BOUND (to Downtown parking)

- Exit 2B to the Smithfield Street and Liberty Avenue garage, or the Ninth Street and Penn Avenue garage.
AFTER THE GAME, exit via Seventh Avenue to the Boulevard of the Allies ramp to I-376 East.

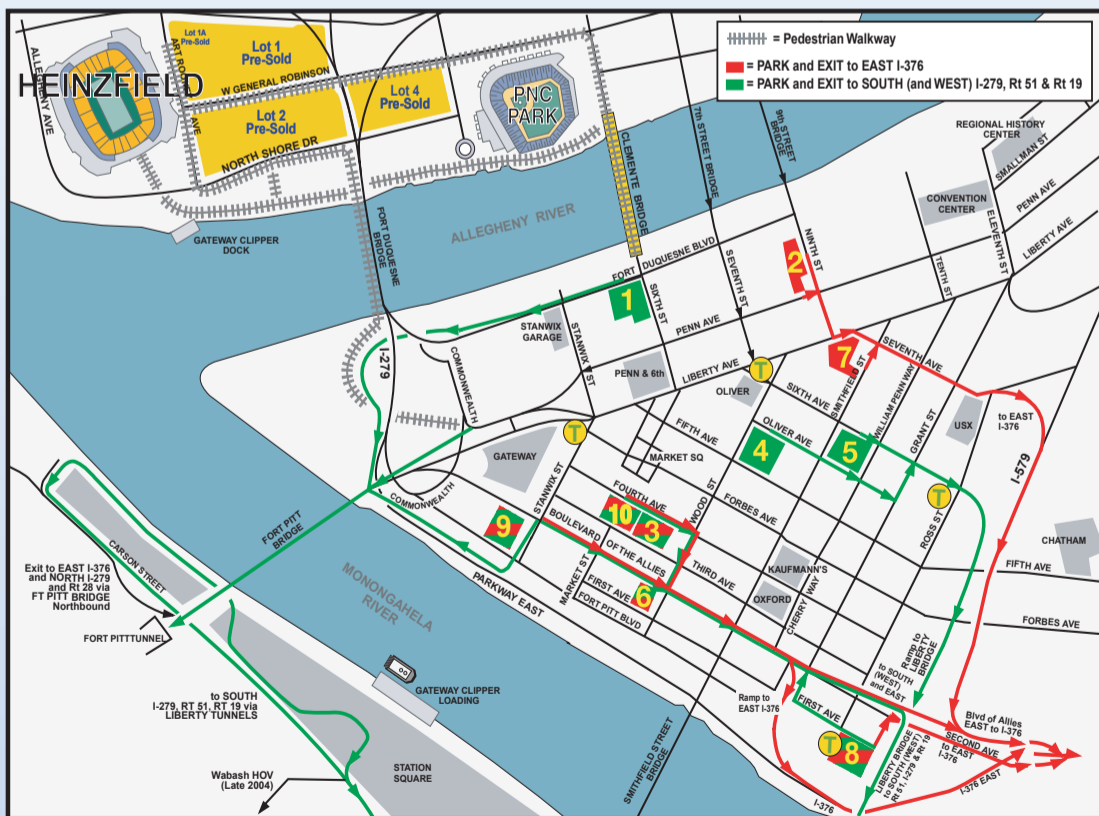
- Exit 1D to the First Side garage. The First Side garage connects to/from the First Avenue "T" Station. You can ride for free to the Gateway Station and walk across the Ft. Duquesne Bridge to Heinz Field.
AFTER THE GAME, take Second Avenue eastbound to enter I-376 East at Bates Street.
- Exit 1C to the First Side garage, the Wood Street and the Boulevard of the Allies garage, or the Third Avenue garage.
AFTER THE GAME, take the Boulevard of the Allies ramp to I-376 East.
